Ms. Steck provided an overview of proposed Post-Secondary Summer Academy that will be held August 14-21, 2016 at Camp Kon-O-Kwee in Fombell, PA. The program has not been approved, but we are proceeding forward with recruitment of potential students. Target audience is high school age students. The students will explore careers, experience postsecondary education programming, visit Butler County Community College, develop self-advocacy skills, and have professional workplace readiness training in a positive environment. Ms. Steck reviewed the daily agenda including speakers' and their topics of discussion, registration process, medical information and medications, staffing ratio, staff clearances, accommodations, possible issues with students attending, graduation ceremony and the picnic. Referrals for the academy would be processed through the OVR counselors, with those being referred needing to be current clients, in 02 status, and currently in school. Applications accepted on a first come first serve basis. A minimum of 25 students are needed for the Academy to occur. Students will not be allowed to have cell phones; emergency phone number will be supplied to parents/guardians. Each

student will receive an I-Pad for journaling and be able to share information with their counselor, school, etc.

Discussion occurred as to the CAC Committee possibly touring Camp Kon-O-Kwee. This will be taken into consideration for the near future.
